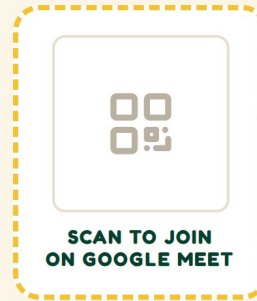

Running It on Google Meet

- The day's counselor hosts; a second counselor manages the chat, mute and the child-turn list.
- Open the game in a browser tab and choose “Present a tab” so sounds come through.
- Call children by name for turns; use thumbs up and Meet reactions for quick answers.
- Ask a parent to sit nearby for the home activity and closing prayer.

BIBLE STORY

The Ten Lepers — Luke
17:11–19

MAIN LESSON

We should not only ask God for things; we should remember to thank Him for who He is and for what He has done.

FAITH BEGINS AT HOME

Saying "thank you" starts at home. The one leper who came back shows us how to thank God and our families out loud.

MEMORY VERSE · PSALM 100:4

"Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name."

OPENING PRAYER

Dear Heavenly Father, thank You for bringing us together today. Thank You because You are good, loving, kind, and faithful. Help us to learn how to have thankful hearts. In Jesus' name, amen.

HOME ACTIVITY · THANKFUL HEART

Cut out a paper heart at home. Write or draw three things about God you are thankful for. Put it on the fridge under the words "WE THANK YOU, GOD!" and add a family member's heart too.

ICEBREAKER GAME · WHO CAME BACK?

Screen-share the game. Ten lepers stand far from Jesus. Each child unmutes and finishes the sentence "I thank God because He is ____" (good, loving, kind, faithful, powerful, patient). With every answer, one leper walks back to Jesus with a cheer. Keep going until all ten come back.

CLOSING PRAYER

Father, thank You for being our wonderful God. Thank You for loving us, protecting us, and caring for us. Help us never to forget Your goodness. Give us thankful hearts every day. In Jesus' name, amen.

- What did Jesus do for the ten men?
- How many came back to thank Jesus?
- Why do you think the other nine didn't return?
- How can we show God, and our family, that we are thankful?

BIBLE STORY

Ruth and Naomi — Ruth 1–4

MAIN LESSON

Families care for one another, and we can thank God for the people He has placed in our lives.

FAITH BEGINS AT HOME

Ruth chose to stay with Naomi and to follow Naomi’s God. Faith grows at home when families love and care for each other.

MEMORY VERSE · EPHESIANS 4:2

“Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.”

OPENING PRAYER

Make a thank-you card for a parent, grandparent, sibling, or guardian. Write: “Thank you for _____. I thank God for you because _____.” Give it to them tonight.

ICEBREAKER GAME · FAITH FAMILY TREE

Screen-share a bare tree. Play “Family Fun”: each child names someone in their family they are thankful for and one fun thing they enjoy doing together (eating together, playing games, going to church, taking trips, cooking). Type the name on a new leaf. By the end the tree is full and blooms.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Who are the people in your family?
- How did Ruth show love to Naomi?
- What is one thing you appreciate about your family?
- How can you help your family?
- What should we do when someone in our family is having a difficult day?

SONG SUGGESTIONS

Jesus Loves the Little Children · Love One Another · If You’re Happy and You Know It (with thank-you actions)

CLOSING PRAYER

Lord, thank You for our families. Please bless every family represented here. Help parents and children love each other and forgive each other. Comfort families who are hurting. Let our homes be filled with Your love. In Jesus’ name, amen.

BIBLE STORY

Hannah Prays for a Child
— 1 Samuel 1

MAIN LESSON

We should remember God's faithfulness and thank Him when He answers our prayers.

FAITH BEGINS AT HOME

Hannah prayed, God answered, and she came back to say thank you. She then raised Samuel to love God at home.

MEMORY VERSE · 1 SAMUEL 1:27

"I prayed for this child, and the Lord has granted me what I asked of him."

HOME ACTIVITY · PRAYER & PRAISE WALL

Tape two papers on a wall at home: "I AM PRAYING FOR..." and "THANK YOU, GOD, FOR..." Family members add sticky notes all week. Remember: God does not always answer in the exact way or time we expect, but He always hears us and cares for us.

What a Friend We Have in Jesus · Give Thanks · Thank You, Lord

ICEBREAKER GAME · PRAYER BALLOONS

Screen-share floating balloons. A child calls out a color, the balloon pops with confetti, and they finish: "I thank God for answering my prayer about ____." Younger children can simply say one thing they are thankful for.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What did Hannah pray for?
- Did Hannah give up?
- How did God answer her prayer?
- What should we do when we are still waiting for an answer?

CLOSING PRAYER

Father, thank You because You hear our prayers. Thank You for every answer we have received and for the times You have helped us. When we have to wait, give us patience and faith. Help us remember that You are always with us. Amen.

Thank God for His Provision

Theme: “God Provides for Me.”

BIBLE STORY

Jesus Feeds the 5,000 —
John 6:1–14

MAIN LESSON

Even when what we have seems small, we can thank God because He is able to provide.

FAITH BEGINS AT HOME

A boy shared the lunch he brought from home, and Jesus gave thanks and made it enough for everyone. What we share from home, God can multiply.

MEMORY VERSE · PHILIPPIANS 4:19

“And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.”

OPENING PRAYER

Dear God, thank You for providing everything we need. Thank You for our food, homes, clothes, schools, families, and friends. Help us remember people who don't have enough and teach us to share what we have. Amen.

HOME ACTIVITY · GRATITUDE JAR

Start a family “Thank You, God” jar. Everyone writes or draws things they are thankful for on small papers and drops them in. Keep adding all week and bring the jar to Saturday’s club meeting.

ICEBREAKER GAME · FILL THE BASKET

Screen-share the boy holding an empty basket. Play “What’s in My Basket?”: each child names something they are thankful God provides (food, shoes, toys, school, a home, friends). Type it in, and a loaf or a fish drops into the basket with their word on it. At the end Jesus blesses the basket, it overflows, and twelve baskets of leftovers appear.

SONG SUGGESTIONS

Give Thanks · Thank You, Lord · Count Your Blessings

CLOSING PRAYER

Father, thank You for everything You provide. Thank You for our daily food, homes, clothes, families, and the people who care for us. Teach us not to be selfish but to share our blessings with others. Amen.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What did the little boy have?
- What did Jesus do with the food?
- What happened to the food?
- What are some things God provides for us?
- How can we share with someone who has less than we do?

Thank God for His Protection

Theme: “God Watches Over Me.”

BIBLE STORY

Noah and the Ark —
Genesis 6:9–9:17

MAIN LESSON

We can trust God and thank Him for watching over us, just as He kept Noah’s family safe in the ark.

FAITH BEGINS AT HOME

God protected Noah’s whole family inside the ark. When they came out, the first thing they did was thank Him together.

MEMORY VERSE · PSALM 91:11

“For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways.”

OPENING PRAYER

Lord, thank You for watching over us. Thank You for protecting us at home, at school, when we travel, and wherever we go. Help us trust You when we are afraid. Amen.

HOME ACTIVITY · PROTECTION PRAYER CARDS

Decorate a card that says “God, please protect ____.” Fill in family members, friends, teachers, or children around the world. Pray over the card together at bedtime.

ICEBREAKER GAME · RAINBOW BUILDER

Screen-share the ark under a gray sky. Play “Safe or Unsafe?”: read a situation and children give a thumbs up (safe) or thumbs down (unsafe) on camera. Examples: wearing a seat belt (safe); running across a busy street (unsafe); telling a trusted adult when someone hurts you (safe); going somewhere with a stranger without telling your parent (unsafe). Each answer adds a color to the rainbow. Wrong answers never take colors away; explain gently.

CLOSING PRAYER

Father, thank You for protecting us. Please watch over our families, schools, churches, and communities. Protect children everywhere, especially those in danger or going through hard times. Help us make wise choices and trust You when we are afraid. Amen.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- How did God keep Noah’s family safe?
- What did Noah’s family do first when they came out of the ark?
- What does the rainbow remind us of?
- What can we do when we are afraid?

BIBLE STORY

Joshua's Choice —
Joshua 24:14–15

MAIN LESSON

Joshua chose for his whole family to serve God. Kids can help their homes serve God every day, in big and small ways.

FAITH BEGINS AT HOME

Serving God starts at home: helping, sharing, praying together, and getting ready for Sabbath as a family.

MEMORY VERSE · JOSHUA 24:15

"But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord."

OPENING PRAYER

HOME ACTIVITY · WELCOME THE SABBATH

Help your family get the house ready for Sabbath, then say a family thank-you prayer at sundown. Add your last notes to the Gratitude Jar and bring it to the club meeting tomorrow.

ICEBREAKER GAME · MY HOUSE SERVES THE LORD

Screen-share a house with rooms. Children suggest ways to serve God in each room: kitchen (helping cook, saying grace), bedroom (bedtime prayer), living room (sharing toys, family worship), yard (kindness to neighbors). Each idea lights up a room with a sticker until the whole house shines.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What choice did Joshua make for his family?
- What are ways your family can serve God at home?
- How can you help your family get ready for Sabbath?
- Who can you be kind to at home this week?

SONG SUGGESTIONS

Give Thanks · This Is the Day · God Is So Good

CLOSING PRAYER

Father, thank You for our homes and families. Bless each home represented here tonight as we welcome the Sabbath. Help us serve You with happy hearts, and bring us together tomorrow to celebrate everything You have done this week. In Jesus' name, amen.

BIBLE STORY

Paul and Silas in Prison
— Acts 16:16–34

MAIN LESSON

Gratitude isn't only for good days.
We can continue trusting and
praising God when life is difficult.

FAITH BEGINS AT HOME

Paul and Silas praised God at
midnight, and that night the jailer
and his whole household believed
in Jesus. Thankful hearts can bless
whole families.

MEMORY VERSE · 1 THESSALONIANS 5:18

"Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

ICEBREAKER GAME · MIDNIGHT PRAISE

Project the game in the room. Read "Thankful or Not?" situations and ask how to respond with gratitude: "You have to clean your room" → "I can thank God that I have a home and do my work cheerfully"; "You are having a difficult day" → "I can still thank God that He is with me." Each answer shakes the prison, until the doors fly open and the chains fall.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Why were Paul and Silas in prison?
- What did they do at midnight?
- What happened to the jailer's family?
- What have you learned about gratitude this week?

OPENING PRAYER

Dear Heavenly Father, thank You for bringing us through this week. Thank You for everything You have taught us. Help us have thankful hearts, not only when things are easy, but also when things are difficult. Help us trust You every day. In Jesus' name, amen.

HOME ACTIVITY · GRATITUDE CELEBRATION

With parents in the room, read some notes from the families' Gratitude Jars aloud. Every child says, "Thank You, God, for ____!" Then everyone says together: "I WILL HAVE A THANKFUL HEART!" Finish with the Final Declaration on the last page.

SONG SUGGESTIONS

Give Thanks · This Is the Day · God Is So Good · Count Your Blessings

CLOSING PRAYER

Father God, we thank You for this wonderful week. Thank You for our families, our friends, our homes, our food, Your protection, answered prayers, and most of all, Your great love. When we are happy, help us say thank You. When we are sad, help us trust You. Give every child here a heart that chooses gratitude every day. In Jesus' name, amen.
